



A PROPOSAL ABOUT SOME SUBJECTS AND TYPE OF ORGANIZATION OF THE PROJECT PARTNERS TO SHARE SOME KNOWLEDGE.

Terms like “social farming” or “social farm” cover different contexts and activities.

MISSION:

What kind and degree of disability do you work with?

Do you work with a particular target age , if yes which one?

Are the disabled people chosen only by you? By others or by common agreement?

THE AIMS:

Are the aims therapeutic and/or rehabilitative?

Educational?

Work Training? (how they are trained?)

Work inclusion

Do you follow a formal or informal approach? Do you apply specific methodologies? If yes which ones?

Do you utilize the case study?

If yes, is it made by specific equipe or all practitioners involved can participate?

Do you make systematic observations? Which methodologies do you use? What 's the object of observation?

PRACTITIONERS:

What's the professional/training background of the practitioners?

What are their roles? What are their tasks?

Are their role directly linked to their professional background?

Are their roles/duties established or can they change during the time and according to circumstances?

TRAINING OF PRACTITIONERS:

Are practitioners trained at the beginning of the job? Do you carry out continuous training?

For the training do you utilize only internal resources or external experts too?

What are the main area covered by the training? Agricultural, educational, therapeutic etc....?

Can you name some of the main problems noticed in the interaction with your disabled persons?

Which aspects do you think are most important in practitioners training? Can you give some example?(Specific problem of disability; what and how to teach or improve, etc..)

RELATIONSHIP WITH THE TERRITORY:

What kind of collaboration/partnership do have you with local, regional or national institutions? (Health Service, Municipality....)

What kind of informal relationship do you have with the resources of the territory? (Community Cultural events, volunteers.....)

ORGANIC FARMING:

Did you choose organic farming? If yes, why? Do you think there is a relationship between this choice and the work with disabled people?
